Exciting lineup of musical activations to be hosted through Sept. 8

August 29, 2019 – As the ultimate host city, Calgary is eager to welcome Country Music Week and the 2019 Canadian Country Music Association (CCMA) Awards from Sept. 5 to 8. To build excitement for the event – and to inspire all Calgarians and visitors involved – the local host committee has planned a series of activations designed to showcase the best of what Calgary's music scene has to offer.



CCMA Hub:	Through Sept. 7, Calgarians and visitors are encouraged to visit the CCMA Hub – located at 120 8 th Ave SW (formerly the Stephen Ave Sport Chek) – to learn about all upcoming Country Music Week 2019 events or to purchase tickets. The CCMA Hub will be open Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
Performances:	Chad Brownlee will kick off a series of pop-up performances by Canadian country music artists on Aug. 31 at the Shaw Charity Classic. From Sept. 3 – 5, pop-up performances will also take place at the arrivals gate at YYC Calgary International Airport and on various C-Train cars and platforms throughout the city.
Off-Country music series:	Hosted at 17 venues along the Music Mile in Inglewood from Sept. 5 through 7, the Off-Country Music Series encompasses over 50 acts that celebrate all music genres that share the same storytelling tradition as country music.
