## APRIL

**6 - 7**  
**Aggie Days**  
Come and see real farm animals, and find out where your food comes from at this free educational experience for families.

**15 - May 4**  
**Calgary Performing Arts Festival**  
One of the largest amateur competitive festivals in North America features performances by emerging musicians and vocalists.

**Easter Eggstravaganza**  
The Calgary Zoo hosts an Easter egg hunt and other fun springtime activities for kids.

**Calgary Underground Film Festival**  
Screenings of feature, documentary, short and animated films that have rarely been shown in North America.

**CALGARY COMIC & ENTERTAINMENT EXPO**  
Visit one of the largest comic and pop culture shows in North America. Meet actors from movies and television shows, listen to themed panel discussions, get your favourite comics signed by the artist, dress up as your favourite characters and shop for merchandise.

**3 - 4**  
**Calgary International BeerFest**  
Sample hundreds of varieties of beer from local and international breweries.

**4 - 5; 10 - 12**  
**Spruce Meadows May Classic I & 2**  
The first outdoor tournaments of the season at Spruce Meadows.

**17 - 19**  
**Otafest - Calgary's Anime Festival**  
Fans of Japanese anime, popular culture and related arts won't want to miss this festival.

**May 20 - 25**  
**YYComedy Festival**  
Bringing laughter with renowned comedians from across North America.

**24 - June 2**  
**Fairy Tales Queer Film Festival**  
A showcase of movies that depict a selection of stories about people in the LGBTQ+ community to celebrate and engage diversity.

**Scotiabank Calgary Marathon**  
The Calgary Marathon is an official Boston Marathon-qualifying race. Other races include the 150 km ultra solo and relay marathon and a 5 km family run and walk.

**FunnyFest**  
This comedy festival features local comedians, magicians, ventriloquists and variety acts.

## JUNE

**Calgary Ukrainian Festival**  
A celebration of Ukrainian culture with traditional food, music, dancing and activities.

**4th Street Lilac Festival**  
Kicking off with a family friendly parade, this neighbourhood street festival features arts and crafts vendors, food trucks and live entertainment.

**5 - 9**  
**Spruce Meadows National CSI 5\***  
Performances by some of the world's best show jumping athletes and horses compete.

**7 - 9**  
**Third Action Film Festival**  
This festival focuses on celebrating the "third act", the last three decades of adult life, to shift how aging is viewed in society.

**8**  
**Calgary ReggaeFest**  
Transform into a "Rastagarian" (a Calgarian who shares the values of reggae music and culture) at this family friendly music festival.

**12 - 16**  
**Spruce Meadows Continental CSI 5\***  
This world-class show jumping competition features some of the best equestrian athletes in the world.

**JazzYYC Summer Festival**  
Enjoy jazz concerts, a club series and the signature JazzWalk on the final Sunday of the festival.

**19 - 23**  
**Sled Island Festival**  
Every year, crowds gather to enjoy an eclectic mix of performances by over 250 musicians, artists, filmmakers and comedians.

**Spruce Meadows Pan American CSI 5\***  
The Spruce Meadows Summer Series concludes with a tournament with the top riders from North America competing. Complimentary admission.

**SHAKESPEARE BY THE BOW**  
Enjoy the timeless appeal of the Bard by taking in an all-ages production of one of his plays performed outdoors at Prince's Island Park. Admission by donation.

**Canada Day**  
Commemorate Canada's 152nd anniversary of confederation with fireworks, live music, activities, food trucks and more.

**Spruce Meadows North American CSI 5\***  
Watch some of the top show-jumping athletes and horses in North America compete, and enjoy family friendly activities, market shopping and a prairie dog showcase.

**Mexifest**  
Sample Mexican cuisine, browse an artisan market and see real luchadores (wrestlers) from Mexico at this celebration of Mexican culture.

**Calgary Stampede**  
A 10-day festival that includes a rodeo and exhibition, midway rides, games and food, concerts and more.

**Roundup Music Fest**  
Big names perform at this charity fundraiser (in 2018, the Goo Goo Dolls and Train performed).

**Fiestaval Festival Latino**  
A free, multicultural festival with plenty of Latin cuisine, music and dancing.



**JULY 25-28**  
**CALGARY FOLK MUSIC FESTIVAL**  
Folk artists from all over the world perform at Prince's Island Park.

**27 - 28**  
**Pet-a-Palooza**  
Don't miss this free, family friendly event dedicated to your furry companions.

**29 - Aug 4**  
**Calgary International Blues Festival**  
Blues music gets its time in the spotlight during this week-long festival.

## AUGUST

**2 - 10**  
**Calgary Fringe Festival**  
See a variety of uncensored, non-juried theatre shows by troupes and performers from around the world.

**3**  
**Inglewood Sunfest**  
The neighbourhood of Inglewood hosts a full day of free all-ages programming, from live music to children's crafts to a vintage car display.

**3 - 4**  
**Chasing Summer Music Festival**  
Western Canada's largest electronic music festival is always a party with multiple outdoor stages showcasing the year's top DJs and electronic artists. Grab your neon body paint and glow sticks and get ready to dance until the wee hours of the morning.

**8 - 11**  
**Taste of Calgary**  
Wander around the outdoor food and drink vendors to sample some tasty creations from restaurants, bars, cafes and food trucks. Enjoy your food alongside live music, browse retail vendors and take little ones to the kids' craft zone.



**AUG 15 - 24**  
**GLOBALFEST**  
Celebrate Canada's cultural diversity with a series of concurrent festivals focused on food, performances and jaw-dropping fireworks displays. Teams from six countries, including Canada, will present spectacular fireworks set to themed music. Before the main event each night, enjoy other themed entertainment, sample regionally-inspired food, make children's crafts and shop for locally-made products at the night market.
